Thought we'd better confirm some of the details for you:

Rough hours of serving/tasting will be Sunday, September 4, 2022, 11:30am to 1:30pm - but may be extended a little depending on demand. We've had about 150 tasters for the last few years, but who knows - usually between these hours there are 300-400 people milling around. We will be charging each taster \$5 - a 'manned' table will be set up to hand out the cups/spoons/tickets and collect the tasting fee. Set-up can start around 10:30am

Each 'taster' will get:

- 3 oz. tasting cup
- spoon
- chili voting ticket.
- table/presentation voting ticket

We will provide each 'Chili Master':

- half (3' x 4') of a 3' x 8' table
- napkins
- electricity
- voting jars
- \$20 towards your food costs

Each 'Chili Master' will bring:

- their own pre-made, pre-heated chili
- large crock pot or equal to keep it warm
- serving utensils (please, only 1 large pot)
- personal signage (name?)
- table decor ??
