If we do not receive this information prior to the upcoming implementation day, you will need to come in person to the post office during business hours to register your address in order to continue receiving mail delivery at your current location.

We will notify you again, in writing, with additional details including the exact date you will start using your new mailing address. **Until that time, please continue to use your current mailing address.**
